INFORMATION FOR ALL Eucharistic Ministers

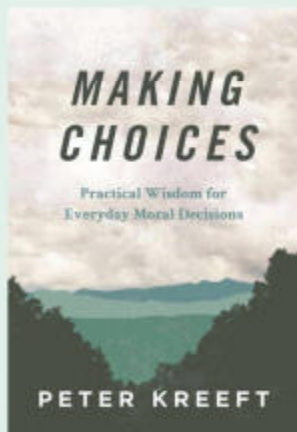
Beginning the weekend of June 5-6th, the Parish will go back to Holy Communion under both forms. This will require more ministers from the congregation at each Mass.

UPDATED MASK
PROTOCOL

On May 13, the CDC announced that fully vaccinated people no longer need to wear a mask or physically distance in any setting except where required by federal, state, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations, including local business and workplace guidance. The two men will take the helm of the largest secondary school in the diocese's system. "Their experience, gifts and expertise will ensure that Helias Catholic has the right leadership to build on its tremendous legacy and fulfill its mission to build a community of saints and scholars for Christ," Bishop McKnight said.

John Knight, who was in formation with the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) at one time and with more than three decades of experience in Catholic education, has successfully served as president since 2007 in four religious and diocesan high schools in California, Michigan, New York, and Wisconsin. He holds a bachelor's degree in special education from the University of Toledo (Ohio), a master's in religious education from Loyola University in Chicago and a post-graduate degree as an education specialist from Oakland University in Rochester, Michigan. Spencer Allen has been principal of St. Joseph Cathedral School since 2007. He has served in various leadership positions in the diocese during that time, including as chair of the Diocesan School Advisory Council, as a member of self-study visitation teams, and as coordinator of numerous professional development sessions. He holds a Bachelor's in education and advanced degrees, including an education specialist in educational administration and leadership from Lincoln University.
