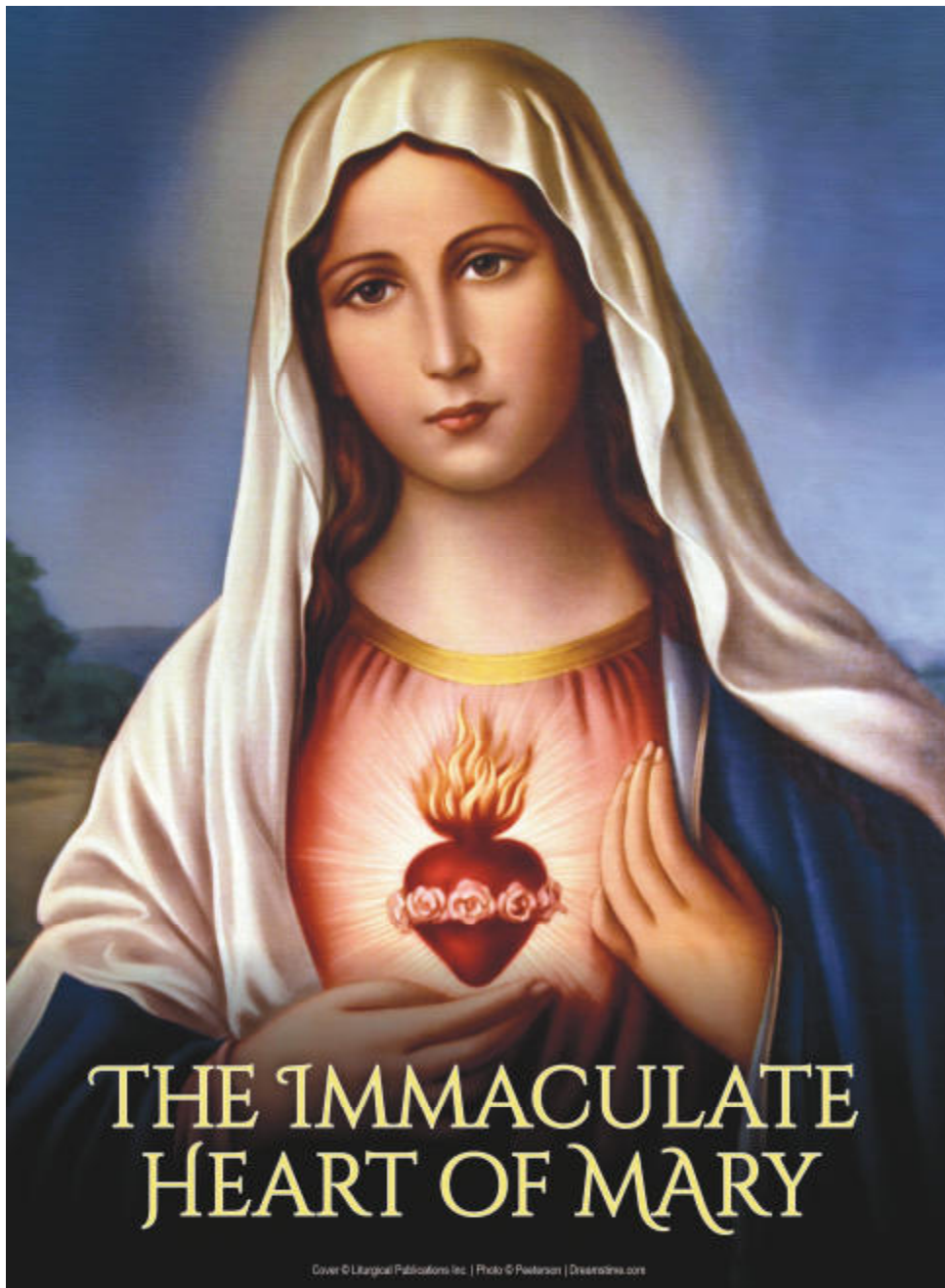

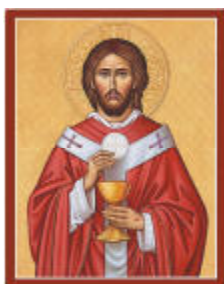

## Do physical and spiritual healings still happen?

In today's modern world we are submerged in the power of science and technology. Is it logical to think that miraculous stories of healing and renewal can happen? The short answer is yes. We have many proofs that demonstrate miracles do still happen. The truth is that Jesus wants to heal us in our minds, our bodies and our spirits today, just as He did when He walked the earth.

Learn about healing the family tree, effects of generational sin, how to pray for family members, spiritual warfare, purgatory, how to nurture spiritual gifts in children and more.

Effects of generational sin on a family line can include: addictions, physical illnesses, depression, suicide, mental illness, history of bizarre accidents and even demonic possession.



Fr. Mark Bozada is a spiritually gifted priest and mystic. He was ordained a priest in 1981 and has served in seventeen parishes throughout his life in St. Louis, Missouri, Oakland, California and Phoenix, Arizona. Father Mark has been in the healing ministry for many years and helped establish the St. John Paul II Institute in 2016 serving as Spiritual Director working together with physicians, nurses, clinical staff, and clergy to unite faith and science.

Father Bozada is well-qualified to speak on the mystical because he is "supersensory" and has had the experience of sensing and even seeing spirits since he was a small child. The gift developed as he encountered the demonic -- including the smell of sulfur as a boy -- and learned to pray harder. That's the negative side. He also experiences -- and sees -- angels and poor souls doing their purgatory on earth -- something that was also associated with Saint Padre Pio.
