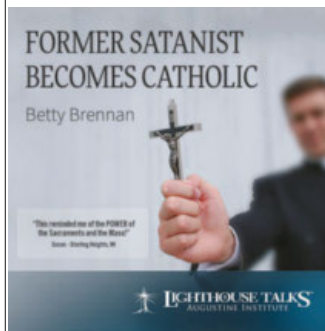
**Christmas Break**—Christmas break will be December 20-January 3.

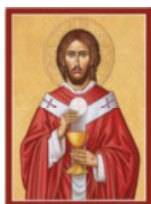

## ANTIPHONS

### Sung at the Entrance or Communion

You may have noticed the Cantors or Choir singing some words before Mass and as our priest receives Communion. These are the Entrance and Communion Antiphons found in the Roman Missal. Singing the Antiphons is not a new practice for the Cathedral.

"The purpose of the Entrance Chant", as explained in the Roman Missal, "is to open the celebration, foster the unity of those who have been gathered, introduce their thoughts to the mystery of the liturgical time or festivity, and accompany the procession of the Priest and ministers." These Antiphons are one of four possible ways to sing at the Entrance procession in the United States.

The Roman Missal further explains, "While the Priest is receiving the Sacrament, the Communion Chant is begun, its purpose being to express spiritual union of the communicants by the means of the unity of their voices, to show gladness of heart, and to bring out more clearly the 'communitarian' character of the procession to receive the Eucharist." Last Easter Sunday and at a recent diocesan celebration we sang Antiphons that were extremely accessible to our people.

The Antiphons are very closely related to the celebrations in which they are sung. They are also closely related to the Scripture of the day. The words for the Antiphons for the weekend Masses may be found in the Missalettes where you find the Readings of the Day.

Singing of the Antiphons WILL NOT REPLACE hymn singing. They are just another option we have for singing at Mass. The Diocesan Liturgical Commission wants all the parishes to be aware of this option.
