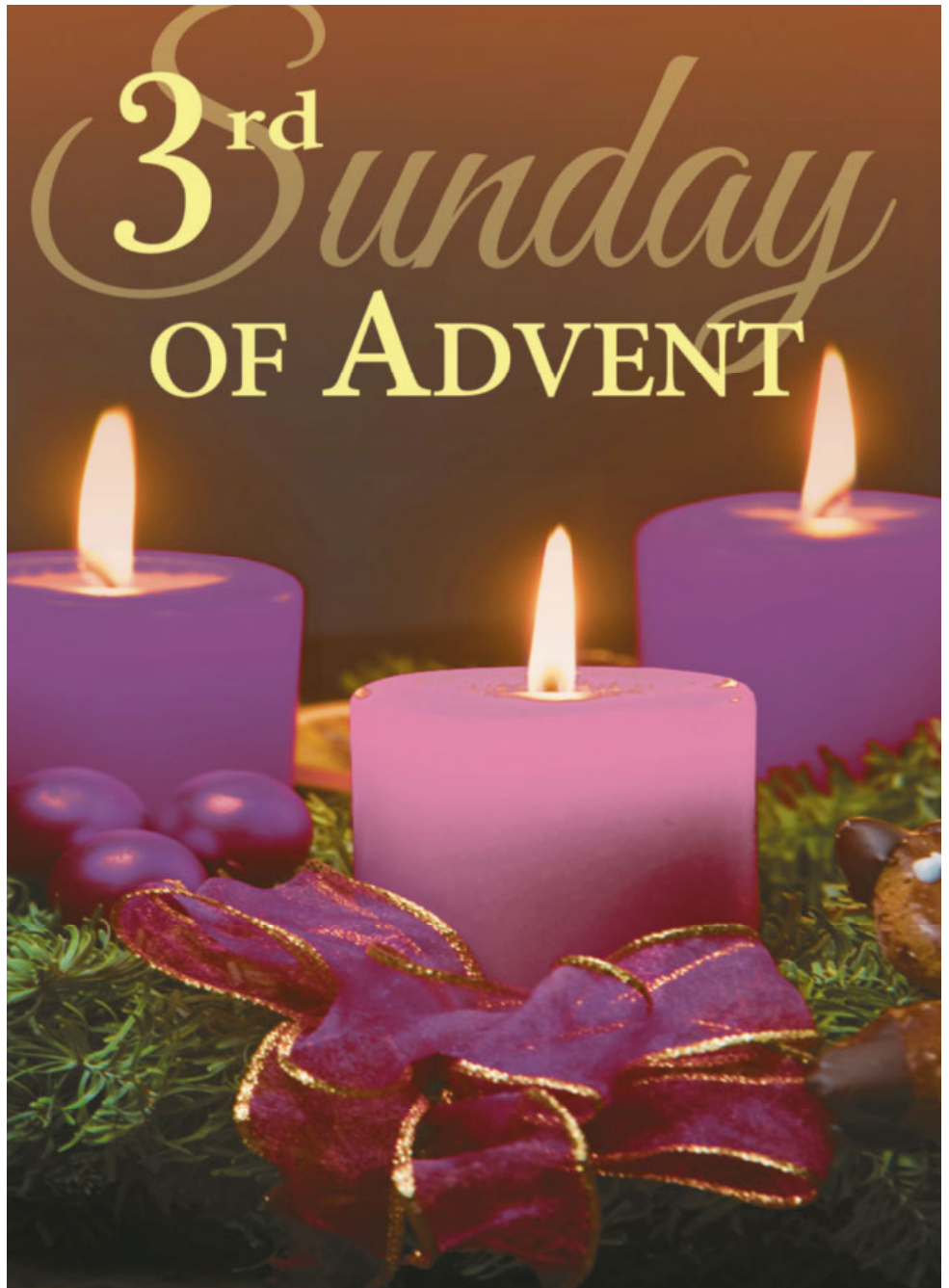

Rehearsals will be in the Cathedral by the Organ.

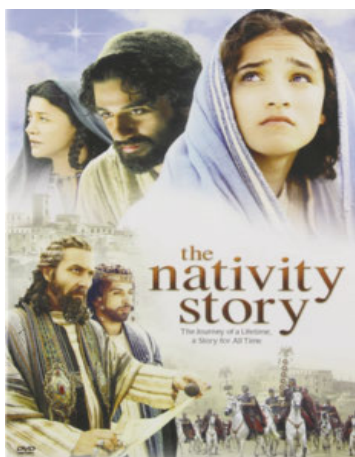

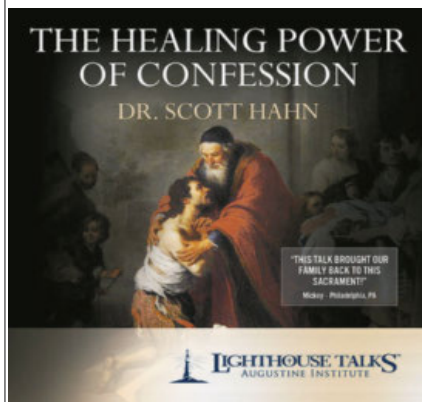


MOVIE AND DINNER

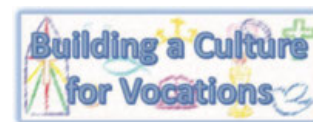

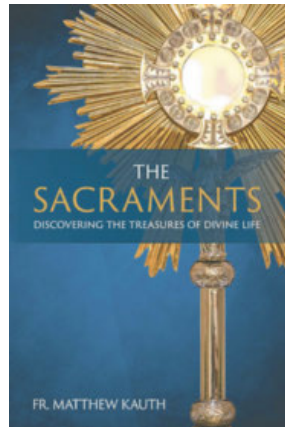

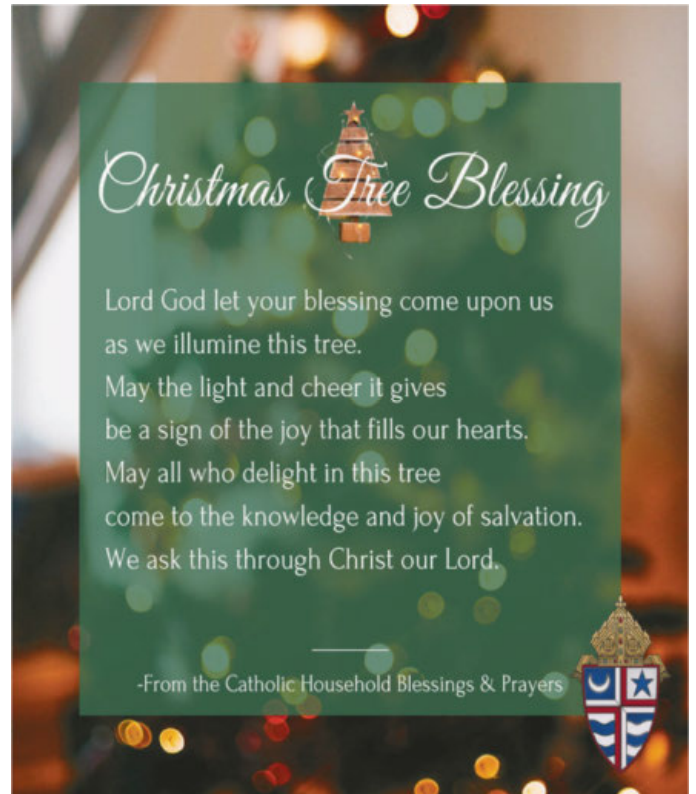
