Update Covid-19 Positive/Quarantine Isolation Updates

If You Tested Positive for COVID-19 (Isolate)

Everyone, regardless of vaccination status.

- Stay home for 5 days.
- At the end of your 5 days, test if possible. If your test is positive, continue to isolate for the next 5 days.
- If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house.
- Continue to wear a mask around other for 5 additional days

If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.

If You Were Exposed to Someone with Covid-19 (Quarantine)

If You:

Have been boosted/

Positive for Covid antibodies

OR

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months

OR

Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months

If You:

Have been boosted

OR

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months

- Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
- Test on day 5.

If you develop symptoms, get a test and stay home.

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- Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
 - If you can't quarantine you must wear a mask for 10 days.
 - Test on day 5.
