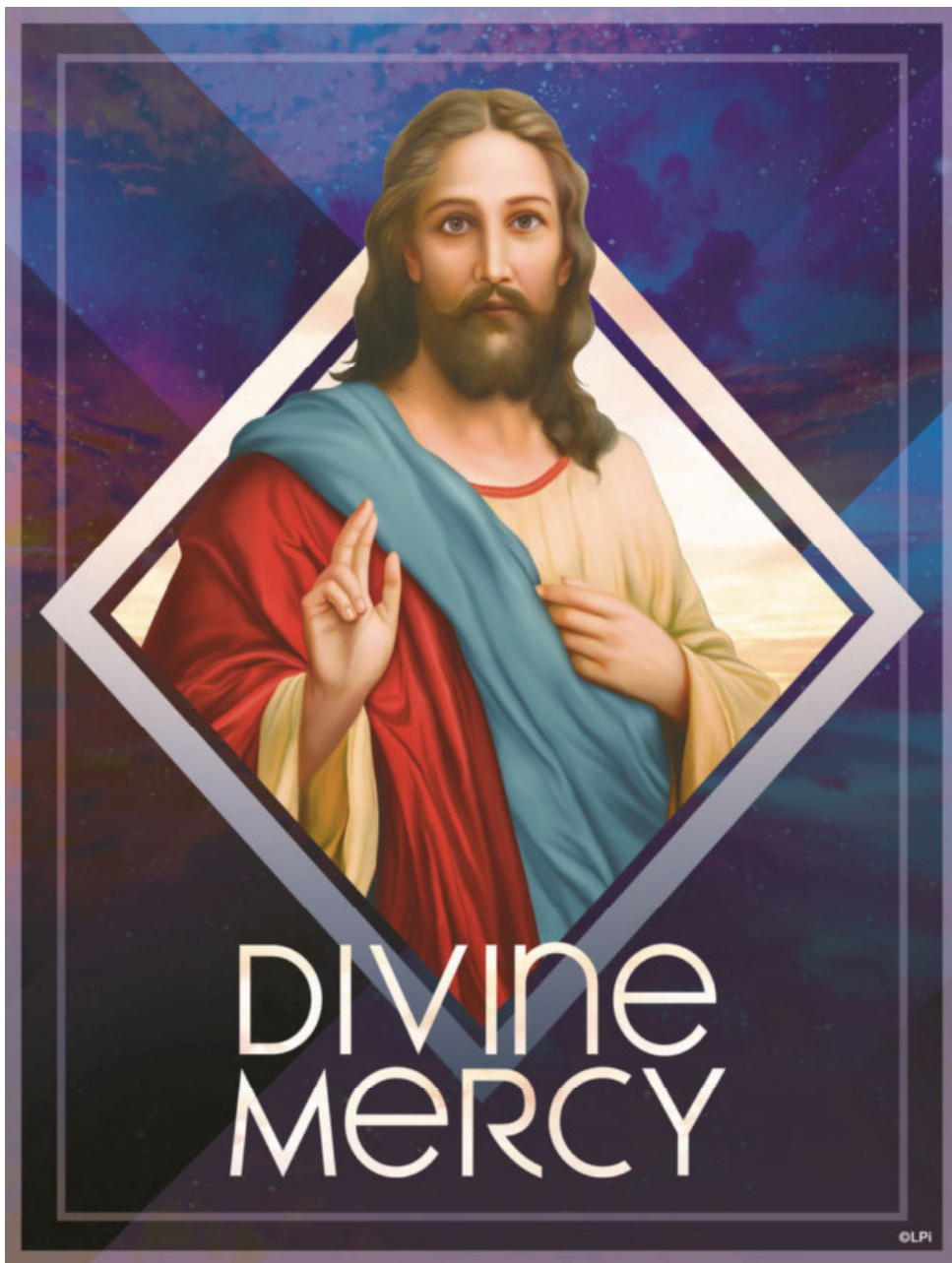

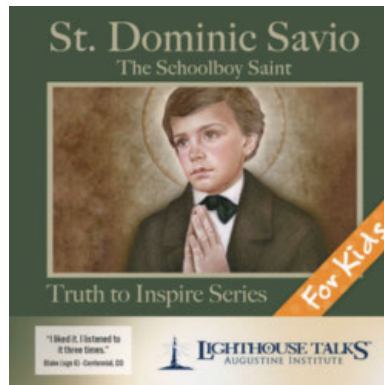

50+ GROUP

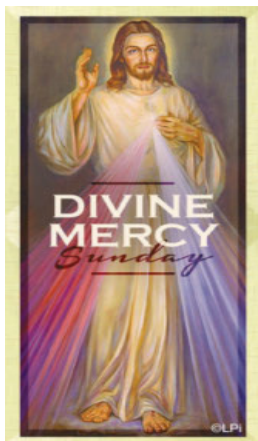

- **PRAYER: A SURGE OF THE HEART.**
Now that Lent is over, finding time to pray can be difficult. Modern life is very busy with so many distractions at every turn, and there's always another job to be done. This inspiring presentation challenges us to make more time for God in our lives and highlights the importance of an ever-deepening life of prayer.
- **WHO IS ST. CATHERINE OF SIENA?** In light of St. Catherine of Siena's feast day, join Dr. Tim Gray and Dr. Elizabeth Klein as they celebrate this holy woman: a nurse and mystic with papal influence who became a doctor of the Church.



On May 5, 2000, five days after the canonization of St. Faustina, the Vatican decreed that the Second Sunday of Easter would henceforth be known as Divine Mercy Sunday.

The Image: Jesus appeared to St. Faustina in a vision with His right

hand raised in a blessing and His left touching His garment above His heart. Red and white rays symbolizing the blood and water that was poured out for our salvation and our sanctification emanate from His heart. The Lord requested that "Jesus, I trust in You" be inscribed under His image. Jesus asked that His image be painted and venerated throughout the world: "I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish" (Diary, no. 48); and "By means of this image[,] I will grant many graces to souls." (Diary, no.742)

WHAT IS A DEACON?
A Permanent Deacon is a man

ordained - like a bishop or priest - to serve as Christ Jesus, who "came not to be served but to serve and to give His life as a ransom for many" (Mark 10:45). The word deacon comes from the Greek word for service: *diakonia*.

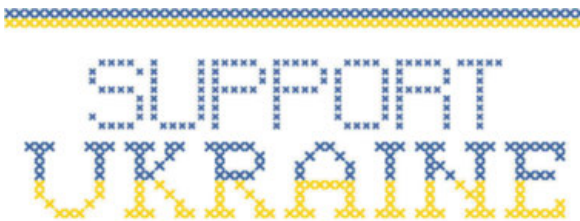
