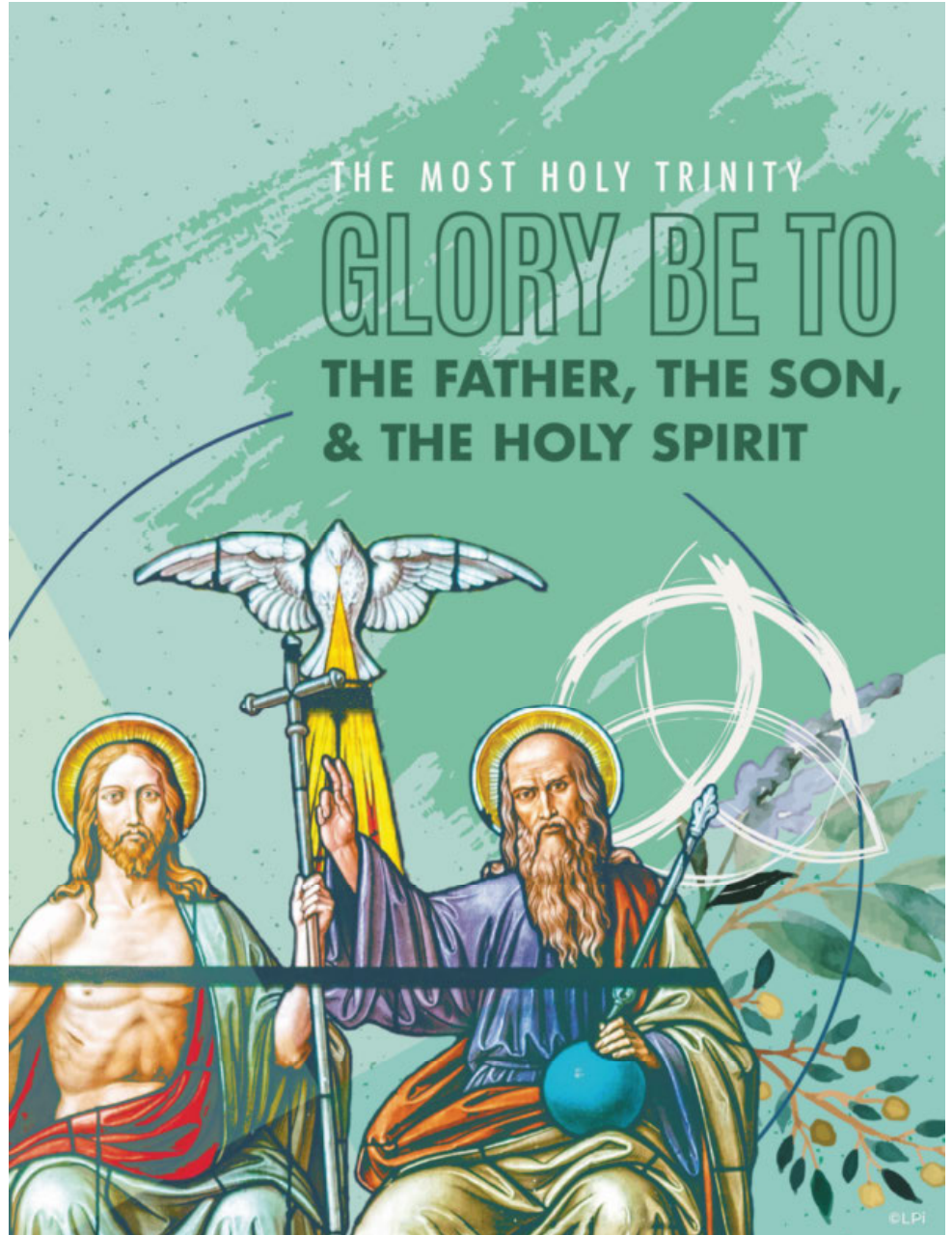

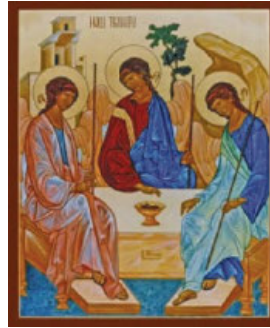

HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY

is celebrated on the first Sunday following Pentecost. Trinity Sunday honors the most fundamental of Christian beliefs—belief that God is three Persons in one Nature. There is only one God, and the three Persons of God—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit—are all equally God, and They

cannot be divided. It was not uniquely celebrated in the early church, but as with many things, the advent of new—sometimes heretical—thinking often gives the Church a moment in which to explain and celebrate its own traditions—things it already believes and holds dear. In the early 4th century, the Arian heresy was spreading. Arianism was the idea that Jesus, as the Son of God, was created by God. This is in opposition to the doctrine of the Trinity, that three distinct persons are united in one Godhead. In response to this heresy, the Church prepared an Office of Prayer with canticles, responses, a preface, and hymns to be recited on Sundays to proclaim the Holy Trinity. Pope John XXII (14th century) instituted the celebration as a feast for the entire Church; the celebration became a solemnity after the liturgical reforms of Vatican II.

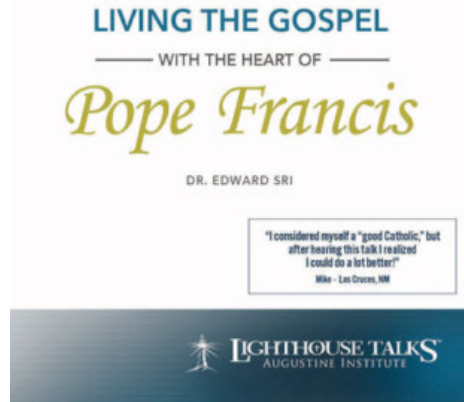
13th-ANNUAL CATHEDRAL GOLF TOURNAMENT

SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

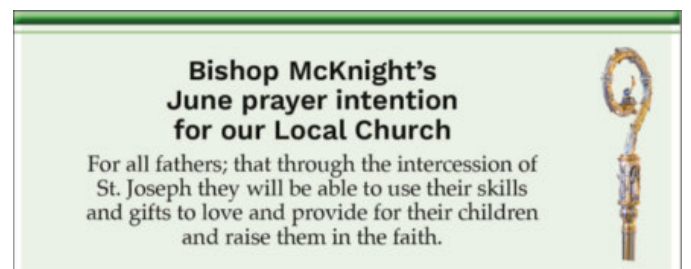
On **June 19, 2022**, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) launches a Eucharistic Revival initiative. Over the next several years, the dioceses of the USA will recommit ourselves to our Eucharistic identity and will reaffirm our faith in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

We believe that the best way to increase faith in the Eucharist is the full and authentic celebration of the Mass – the source and summit of our faith (Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, 10). Adoration of the Eucharist flows from the Mass and leads us back to it.
