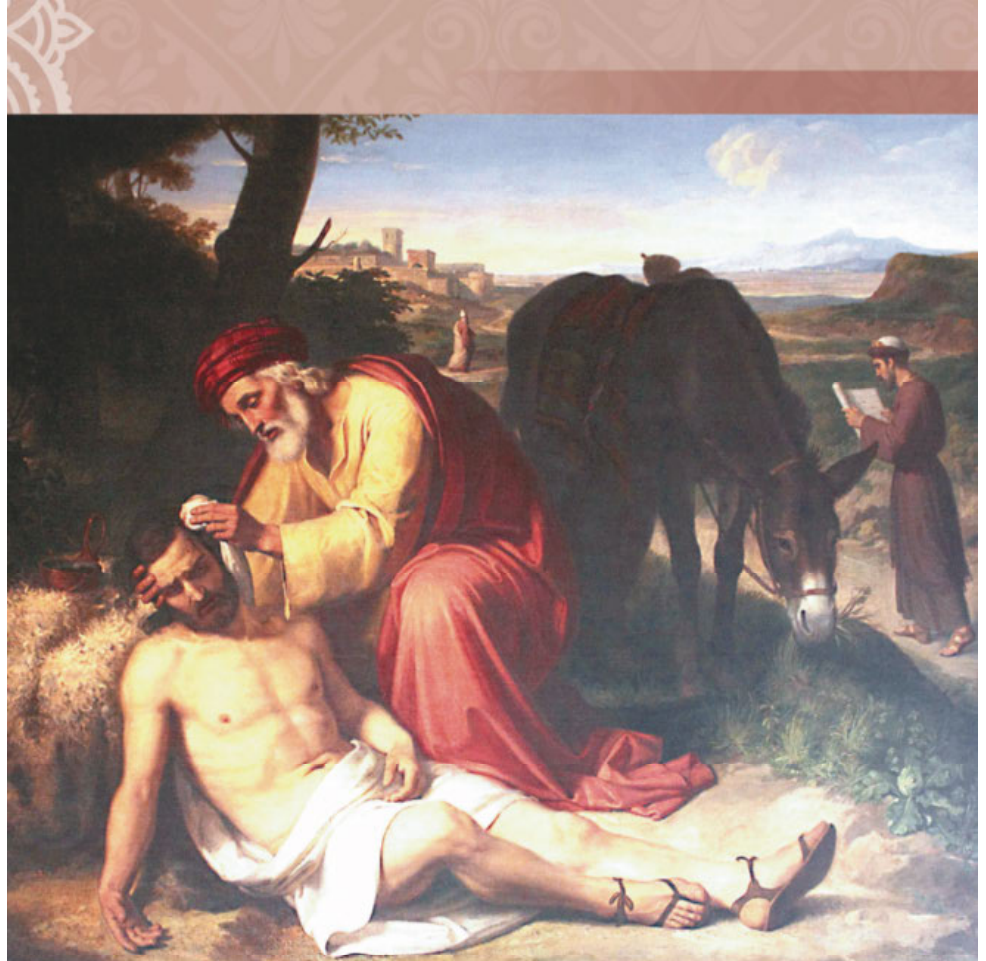

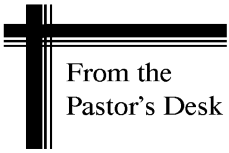

From the Pastor's Desk **Pastoral planning notes**

Since there aren't any available associate pastors to replace Fr. Iggy, we will need to adjust our weekday Mass schedule. I know that this has become an annual occurrence, and I appreciate your acceptance of change as it comes our way. The good news is that Fr. Stephen Jones, our diocesan Director of Stewardship, is available to help with a couple of our weekday Masses. Therefore, considering his schedule as well the school's and my own, the new weekday Mass schedule will be:

- Mon. 8:00 a.m.
- Tues. 6:30 a.m.
- Wed. 6:30 a.m. & 8:00 a.m.
- Thurs. 6:30 a.m.
- Fri. 6:30 a.m. & 8:00 a.m.
- Sat. 8:00 a.m.

This schedule will take effect beginning Monday, July 18.

The 6:30 a.m. Masses and the 8:00 a.m. Mass on Saturdays will continue to be held at the Chancery. While school is not in session, the 8:00 a.m. Masses on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays will be held in the Adoration Chapel. Regrettably, we cannot continue to offer a 12:10 p.m. Mass at the Cathedral due to the other pastoral duties to which Fr. Jones and I must attend during the day.

It has also come to my attention that we don't have sufficient time between the 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. Masses on Sundays to celebrate baptisms with the reverence they deserve. I therefore consulted with the Parish Council regarding the possibility of gaining an extra half-hour between those two Masses. It is our consensus that the best solution is to shift the 8:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday to 7:30 a.m. So, **beginning on Sunday, July 24, the Sunday Mass schedule will be 7:30 a.m. & 10:00 a.m.** Confessions will remain on Saturday afternoon from 3:30-5:00 p.m. at the Adoration Chapel, and Saturday evening Masses will remain at 5:30 p.m.

Finally, please help me to welcome two new members to our parish staff. Beginning next month, Anna Porting will become our new Director of Youth Ministry, with Julie Gramlich now focusing exclusively on our Adult Faith Formation efforts. Anna comes to us from Our Lady of Lourdes in Columbia, where she held the same position in that parish. Additionally, Steve Meystrik will become our new Stewardship Coordinator on a full-time basis in January, 2023, following his retirement from the Missouri Department of Transportation. I extend my thanks to Julie Gates for her hard work as our initial Stewardship Coordinator and look forward to her continued input on our Stewardship Committee.

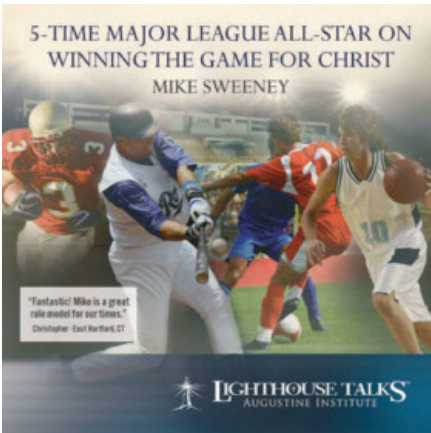

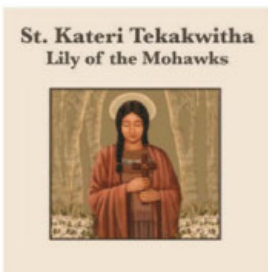
