

# PERMISSION FOR ADMINISTERING MEDICATION AT SCHOOL

2022-2023

- Medications should be administered by a parent or guardian before or after school hours, when possible. Initial doses of a medication that a child has never had before should NOT be given at school.
- In order to assure your child is receiving the proper medication and dosage, please fill out the form completely. **A separate form is required for each medication and child.**
- Prescription medications must be in their original labeled container provided by the pharmacist who filled the prescription. This container must include the child's name, physician, dosage and administration instructions.
- Non-prescription medications should preferably be in their original labeled container. If not possible, the medications must be easily identifiable (i.e. tablets marked with the medication name or wrapped cough drops).
