33 DAYS TO MORNING GLORY

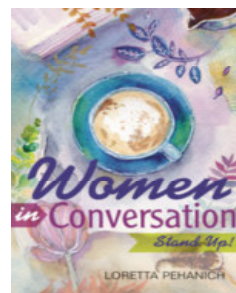
