Ideas for Celebrating Feasts/Memorials in June:

6/2 - Solemnity of Corpus Christi: attend Mass and receive communion, also a great day to visit the Blessed Sacrament.

6/7 - Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus: In 1963, Jesus began appearing to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque and told her that he desired a feast day devoted to his Sacred Heart, and that the faithful receive Communion on the first Friday of each month, (and other requests) and though it took 100 years, the First Friday devotion began.

6/8 - The Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary: Make heart-shaped cookies  and share with friends to spread Mary's love. "My Immaculate Heart will be your refuge and the way that will lead you to God."

6/13 - Feast of St. Anthony of Padua: "The Hammer of Heretics," and the finder of lost items. Pray to St. Anthony: "Dear St. Anthony, please come 'round, Something is lost that can't be found."-Amen
Spend some time today on a **scavenger hunt** looking for things that must be found!

6/16 - Fathers' Day: Children, write a prayer to God for your dad for why you are thankful that God chose him.
*Bonus: write a card to your local priests to thank them for their guidance in your faith.

6/24 - Solemnity of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist:

- John was the first to "leap for joy" in his mother's womb when Jesus came to Earth. Have a **dance party** & join John in leaping for joy (highly recommend "Joy" by for KING + COUNTRY or "Happy Dance" by MercyMe)!
- Spend the day **swimming** (bonus points if you swim in a river!) in honor of his baptizing of many!
- Have some **birthday cake** to celebrate his birthday!

6/29 - Solemnity of Sts. Peter & Paul: go fishing for St. Peter and/or **sleep in tents** for St. Paul.
