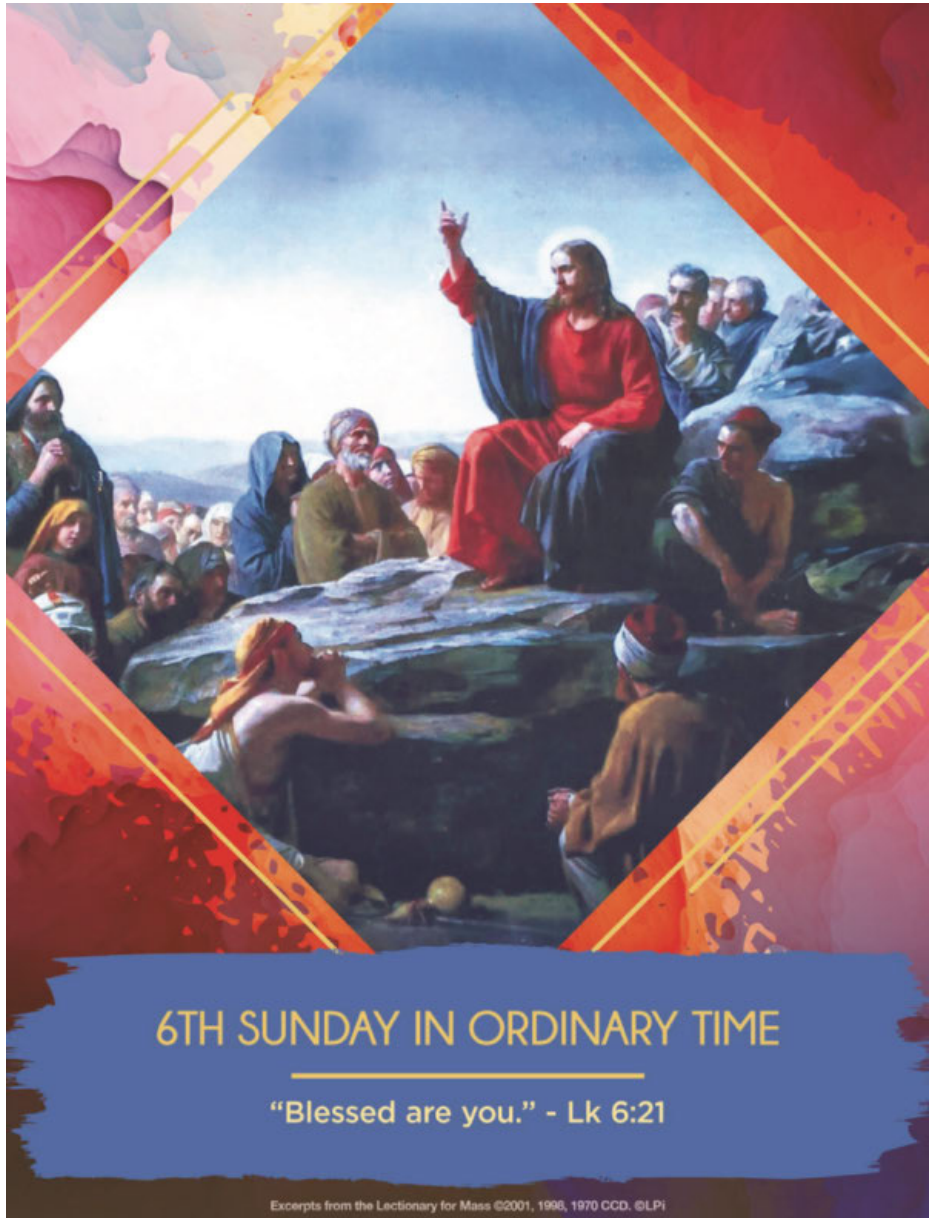



It is administered by Bishop McKnight, and signifies the Church's "election" of these individuals to receive the Sacraments. This rite emphasizes God's faithfulness and the commitment of the elect to follow Christ.

NCYC 2025
