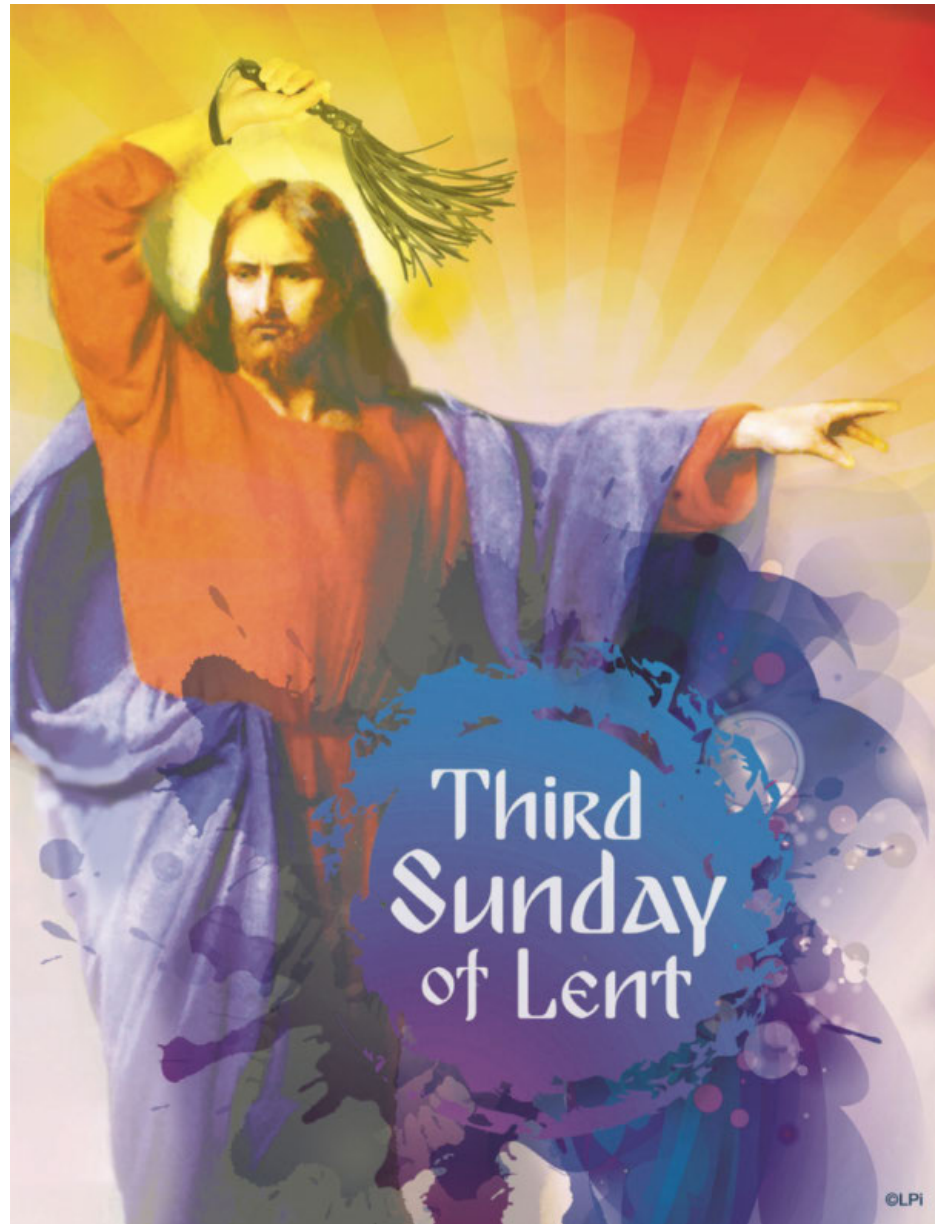

SAFE HAVEN BABY BOXES

Cole County EMS has raised \$1,500 toward the \$15,000 needed to bring a Safe Haven Baby Box to Jefferson City. The mission is to prevent the illegal abandonment of newborns. How it works:

- When a baby is placed in the box, it locks and an alarm sounds
 - Emergency personnel open the box and take the baby to a hospital
 - The baby is then put through foster care resources

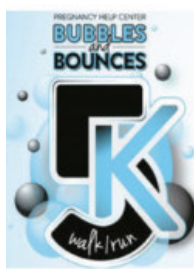
