New Cemetery Clean-Up Policy

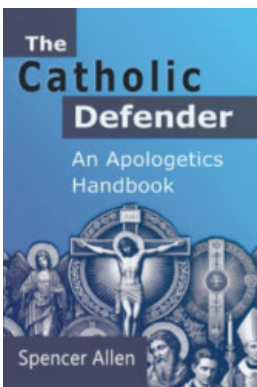
Catholic Cemeteries of Jefferson City
The following changes will apply to both Resurrection and St. Peter cemeteries. There will be no scheduled clean-up days throughout the year.

The following rules will be enforced:

- All artificial flowers must be in a vase.
- No glass objects of any kind.

From April 1 to October 31 of each year, all objects deemed by management to hinder ground maintenance shall be removed.

The management reserves the right to remove any objects that are not allowed by the rules and regulations of the Catholic Cemeteries of Jefferson City.
