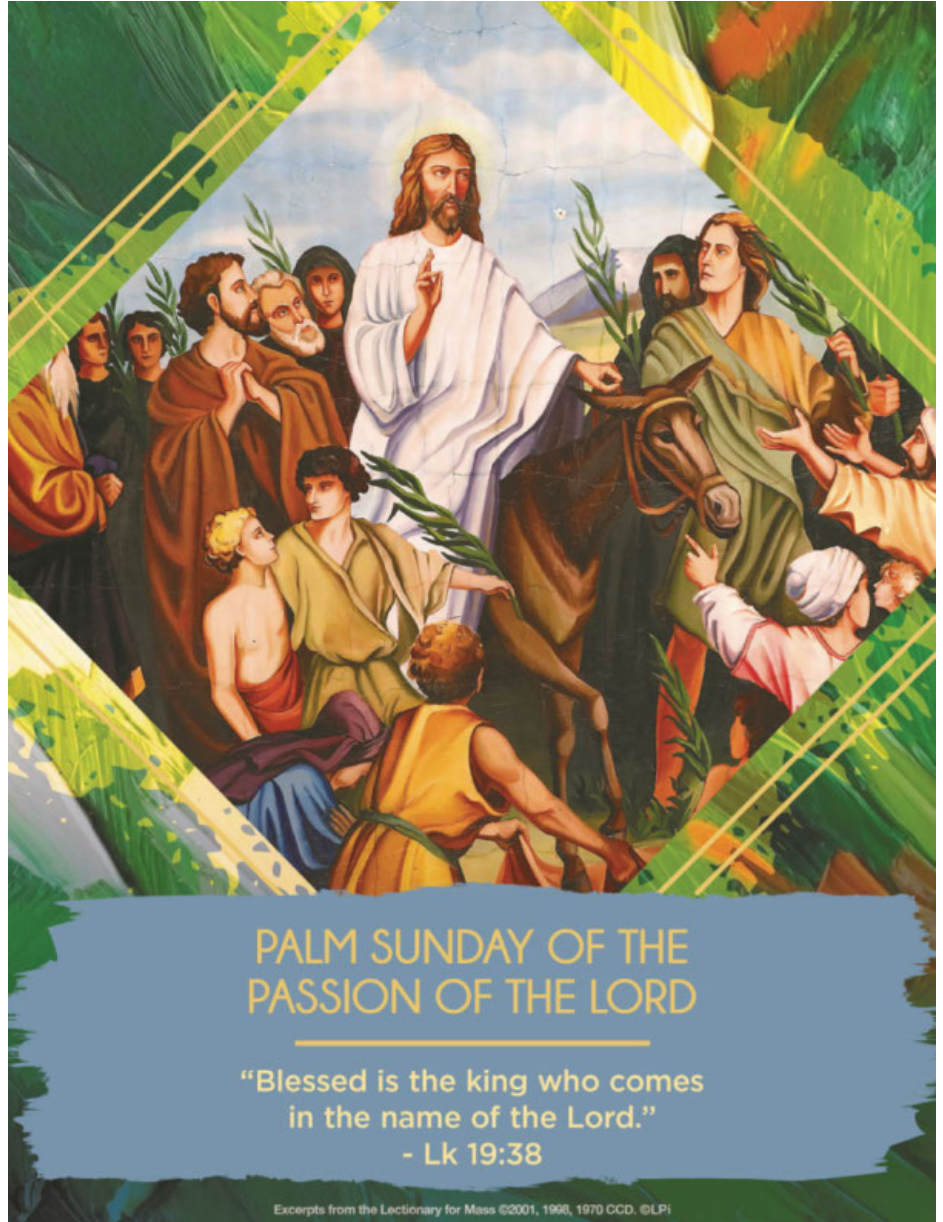

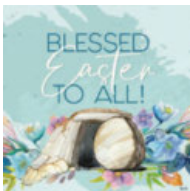

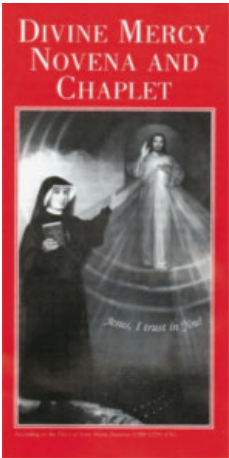

ONE NIGHT-SEVEN CHURCHES, Holy Thursday, Apr. 17

We invite you to participate this year in a centuries-old tradition of venerating at least seven Altars of Repose following Holy Thursday Masses by visiting these seven churches: St. Peter, Jefferson City; Cathedral of St. Joseph, Jefferson City; Immaculate Conception, Jefferson City; St. Francis Xavier, Taos; St. Stanislaus, Wardsville; St. Andrew, Holts Summit; and St. Martin, St. Martins.

Upon entering each church, pilgrims visit the altar of repose, kneel, make the sign of the cross, read the appropriate scripture for each station, and engage in private prayer and adoration. Pamphlets and stickers will be available at each church for you to record your visits.
