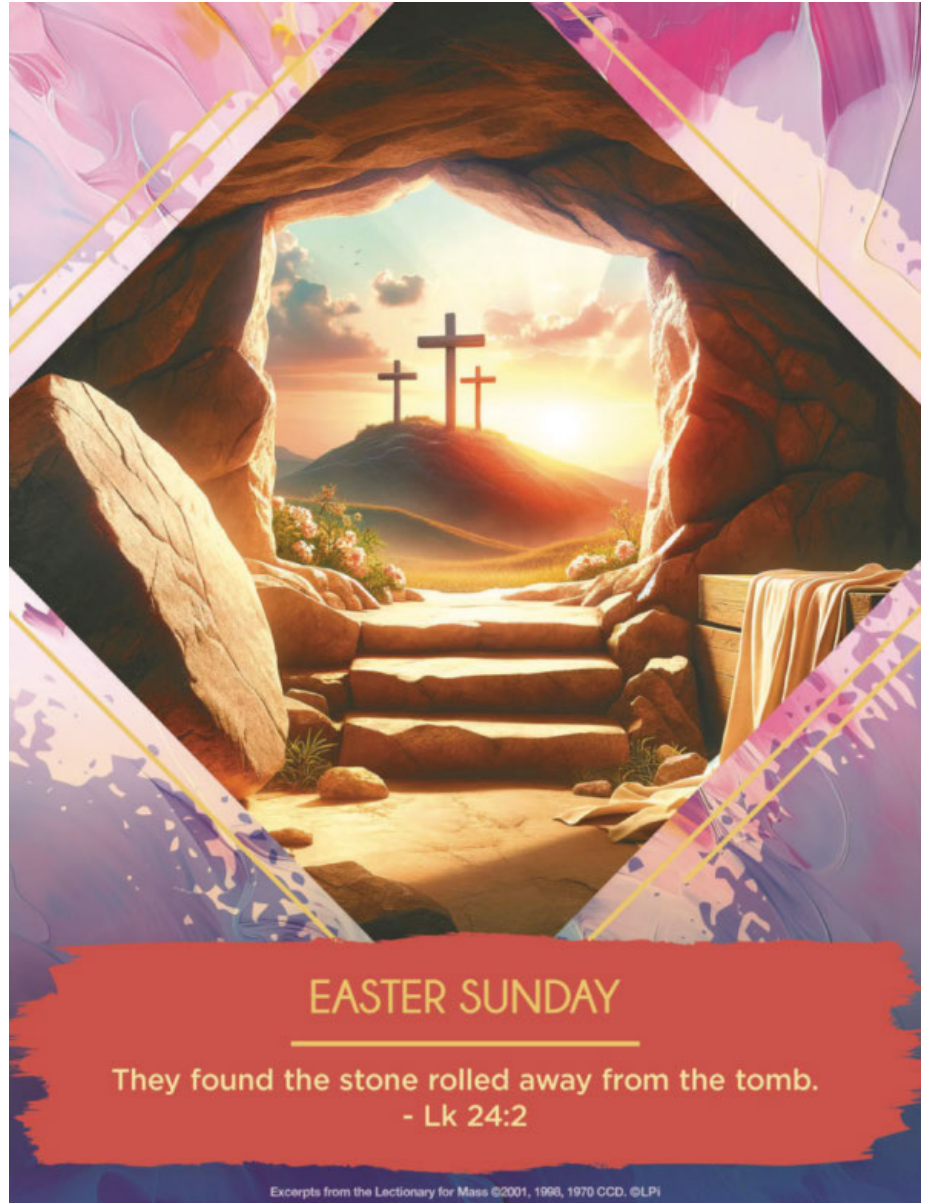

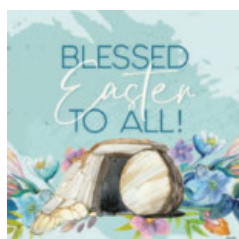

Our initial response to someone who is disclosing abuse for the first time must be compassionate.
